COVID -19 - Additional Requirements For Club Operations – Phase 1

The Murray Bridge Rifle Club will adhere to and manage additional requirements, as a consequence of the COVID-19 pandemic, as outlined below on our range situated in the Monarto Shooting Complex at 52 Rifle Rd, Monarto, SA.

These requirements will exceed all other policies and procedures already enforced within the Club and will be adjusted accordingly to remain in line with current requirements and restrictions placed upon us from all governing bodies and current SA Government Emergency Management Directions and the National Reboot framework. The Murray Bridge Rifle Club promotes the use of the COVIDsafe app.

Arrival at the range

On arrival, all people attending the range will need to sign in to a separate COVID-19 register available outside the clubrooms. A contact phone number should be included in the case of non-members to assist with tracing if the need arises. Individuals will be responsible for their own writing implement.

Clubrooms

A sign will be erected at the designated entry point to the clubrooms indicating the maximum number of people permitted to be within the clubrooms at any one time, in line with current area and social distancing rules. This sign will be updated as these rules are revised by the governing bodies.

There will be a separate designated exit point to allow for social distancing.

Hand sanitising will be available at the point of entry and the point of exit.

Only designated personnel will be allowed to operate food and drink outlets to minimise cross-contamination. All food and drink outlets will operate according to the Current Emergency Management Direction.

No unnecessary loitering to occur in the clubrooms at this time and signs will be erected to promote social distancing.

Correct money where possible or alternatively direct deposit into Club's account.

Clubrooms are to be cleaned at the end of each day.

Toilet facility

A sign will be erected at the doorways to the toilets indicating the maximum number of people permitted to be within the toilet facility at any one time in line with current area and

social distancing rules. This sign will be updated as these rules are revised by the governing bodies. Antibacterial liquid soap will be available and encouraged for handwashing and single use paper towel will be provided to help stop the spread of germs.

Social distancing will be adhere to where possible.

Use of the shower facilities will be prohibited for the duration.

Toilet facilities are to be cleaned at the end of each day.

Range set up

Range set up will be allocated to members that are able to perform setting up duties on a daily basis I.E, target set up and flagging of the range, transportation. Where possible, these same members will be responsible for packing away the same equipment to limit potential cross-contamination. This will be recorded in the COVID-19 register so we can monitor movement throughout the range. The protocol around these responsibilities will be monitored and updated accordingly to align with current requirements. Where possible social distancing and hygiene protocols will be in place.

Firing line protocol

The Club will adhere to current firing line measures laid out by the governing body, the South Australian Rifle Association. These measures will also comply with current rules and regulations in place by the SA Government.

If the number of individuals present is more than the maximum number currently permitted to gather, then separate groups will be formed to comply with requirements. These groups must be clearly distinguishable from each other and unnecessary co-mingling must be kept to a minimum.

Each group is to utilise parking as closely but safely to their assigned target and still adhering to social distancing practices within their group.

If social distancing is not possible to maintain on the firing line then a delay will occur to allow the previous shooter to leave the mound in a safe but efficient manner before the next shooter approaches the mound. The new shooter will not start until the person who will score for their entire round has returned and instructed them to start.

All electronic devices that will be interchanged within the group, must be disinfected and sanitised accordingly before being used by another member.

No sharing of equipment, unless it is between individuals from the same residential address.

If sharing is needed, equipment must be disinfected between uses.

All equipment to be cleaned and disinfected at the end of the day.
